- Ensure occupational rehabilitation for injured/ill employees without them being prejudiced or disadvantaged, and ensuring that effective return to work plans are developed and implemented.
- Identify competencies required for the establishment and management of a safe and healthy workplace, and ensure such competencies are always retained within our workforce.
- Identify potential emergency situations and establish procedures for their prevention and response.
- Communicate with our staff and engage with other stakeholders to reduce workplace risks and improve health conditions.
- Maintain a certified Safety Management System in accordance with the requirements of AS/NZS 4801:2001.
- Ensure employees and sub-contractors comply in full with our Safety Management System.
